We “Just Five” team, are asking your organization to support the “House of Hope” project. Our team is part of Leadership Skagit class of 2010, and has partnered with Skagit Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Services (SDV & SAS) as part of our Community Involvement Project. The project entails the renovation and beautification of the SDV & SAS safe house shelter for women and children. Currently, the shelter houses, on average, 20-30 women and children each month, and also provides outreach programs to support those women in taking steps towards improving their circumstances.

Presently there are 7 guest bedrooms. The project will encompass the renovation of the guest rooms as well as the general living spaces. In the future, the agency would like to remodel the basement to include additional guest rooms and living space.

In addition to general cosmetic repair, the project will create long term sustainability for the organization as a whole by fostering community relationships.

We selected this project because it touched our hearts. The services that this agency provides are significant to the welfare of our community. It is our hope that other members of the community will find in this project an opportunity to contribute to those in need. Our ultimate goal is to foster long term relationships between the businesses, business leaders of this community and the agency itself.
